DESIGNING A CHARACTER

What potential names do you have for the character?
What is the character's bio? For example, history, likes, dislikes, quirks or hobbies.
What is the rough age of your character?
Choose five words that describe the physical features of the character. e.g. strong, tired or bright.
What would you like people to feel when they see your character? e.g. hopeful or not alone.
Is there a design style you'd prefer? e.g. Urban, street style, manga or Disney.
What are they wearing?
Is there a reason they are wearing what they are wearing? For example, a hoodie to hide their face.
What is the colour scheme? Is there a reason for the colours choice?
Choose 5 characteristics you'd like people to see in the character. e.g. hope.
Any extra information? The more, the better.

YOU MAY NOT GET IT RIGHT FIRST TIME ROUND, WE DIDN'T! PERSEVERE! REVIST WHAT YOU'VE DONE A FEW DAYS AFTER TO SEE IF YOU ARE STILL HAPPY WITH IT OR IF IT NEEDS A TWEAK.
